1. Minutes - **Approved**
2. ETA Service
 - a. Did lab plugs get reworked by Dan? **Dan did not get completed over the break but hope to have this done over the summer months.**
 - b. Updates on log for issues in lab with Thin Clients – **Still having issues with browser. Using Google Chrome but two computers continue to give intermittent issues. Next thought is to go try Fire Fox. Chris is going to have Tony load this onto the lab server and make it the default browser. We will follow back up to see if this fixes the problem.**
 - c. Windows 2010 License location – **License is owned by Archdiocese and is shared. Teachers are allowed one work and home application to use. Chis will get the info needed to get Mary set up.**
 - d. Any other new issues? – Maintenance tank message came up on Epson Stylus plotter. This is the reservoir that is used to collect waste as heads are cleaned. Steve puled the tank and replaced it.
 - e. **Parish Computers – Parish purchased 7-8 new computers and received 5 donated computers from Landmark. Chris has cleaned up the donated machines and is waiting for the new ones so he can set them up and turn them all over to the Parish.**
 - f. **Teachers are complaining about student machines getting slow. We recently invested in updating the RAM on these machines at the beginning of the year but performance continues to fade. Discussed serviving the machines but for now we will put that off and have the students work from the lab if need be. We discussed the option of turning these machines into Thin Clients which means they need the \$200 thin client box and a hardwire connection for each machine. We will wait to see how the lab option works before moving forward with other options.**
3. Electronic Library Card Catalog Initiative
 - a. **Progress Update – Plan is to wrap up the implementation next week Wednesday. Should be ready to go live with next year's school year. Drew rasied funds to cover fees for the next two school years and is going to discuss extending an additional year due to the roll out that is at the end of the school year which resulted in a year of missed free service. Idea is to check out books the students lunch room number is scanned and the book would be assigned to that.**
